

# The Arthur Allister MacBain Memorial Scholarship

# \$20,000

Tenable at Dalhousie Law School

The Arthur Allister MacBain Memorial Scholarship was established by John H. MacBain, in memory of his father, Arthur Allister MacBain (LL.B. Dalhousie, 1951). This renewable scholarship is awarded annually to a student entering first year at Dalhousie Law School who has achieved academic excellence and has demonstrated significant involvement in extracurricular and community activities.

**Eligibility:** The applicant must have completed, with a superior academic average, at least three full years after junior matriculation or two full years after senior matriculation of a course leading to a degree at a degree-granting college or university recognized by the Senate of Dalhousie University. A “superior academic average” is determined by evaluating the applicant’s performance in college or university, and the applicant’s LSAT score. The applicant will also be required to demonstrate to the selection committee a history of involvement in and commitment to community service and extracurricular activities. The recipient of the scholarship must accept a place and take up attendance in the first year class at Dalhousie Law School.

**Method of Selection:** The Arthur Allister MacBain Memorial Scholarship selection committee, consisting of the Chair of the Dalhousie Law School Admissions Committee, the Dean of Law, and two other members of the Faculty of Law at Dalhousie University will select the recipient of the Scholarship based on the criteria outlined above. An interview may be requested by the committee. Decisions of the committee are final.

**Conditions for Renewal:** The Arthur Allister MacBain Memorial Scholarship is renewable for a second and third year, provided that the recipient maintains an average of B+ or higher in Law School studies. The Scholarship is renewable only at Dalhousie Law School.

**Application:** Each candidate is required to make application using the form on the reverse. It is to be postmarked no later than the last day of November and returned to:
