

APPLICATION FORM CRAIG BAUER MEMORIAL PRIZE

The Craig Bauer Memorial Prize fund was established to celebrate and remember the life of Craig Bauer by supporting an annual prize to a Dalhousie Law School student who best exemplifies the traits that made Craig Bauer a special person, specifically, outstanding academic achievement and excellence in intramural sports.

This annual prize of \$250 is awarded to the student who has completed first year, and who will be entering second year. The recipient will be the student "who has achieved a high grade in first year Torts and who has participated in at least one intramural sport."

The Studies Committee will award the prize. However, because the Committee only has access to information regarding a student's standing in Torts, and not their participation in intramural sports, this application form has been designed to elicit that information. Thus the winner of the prize will be a student who has a) demonstrated their involvement in intramural sports through filling out this form; and b) achieved a high grade in first year Torts. The Studies Committee reserves the right to not award the prize in any given year if no applications are received, or if none of the applicants have a sufficiently high standing in Torts.
