The Boyne Clark Prize was established in 1994 by the law firm of Boyne Clarke.

This annual prize of \$1,000.00 is awarded to the first year student from Nova Scotia who has demonstrated excellence through a combination of academic achievement, participation and contribution to the law school and the broader community.
