

Pre-and Co-requisites and Information about Recommended Courses

The online registration system will not remind you of pre- or co-requisites when you register. However, all student registrations are subsequently audited for compliance. If you register for a course without having already taken the prerequisite, or without having registered concurrently for a co-requisite, you will be required to drop the class.

- A prerequisite must be completed prior to commencing the course in question (i.e. either in the previous year or the previous term). If you do not have the necessary prerequisite, you must not register for the course in question.
- A co-requisite must either be completed prior to commencing the course in question or, at the very least, must be taken concurrently with the course in question (i.e. in the same term, not in a later term). In this situation, unless you have already completed the course or are registered for it in the same term, you must not register for the course in question.

The following is a list of courses with prerequisites, co-requisites or recommended courses.
