To all returning upper-year law students:

Please take a moment to read this important information from the Associate Dean's Office:

Registration for 2011-12 will begin at 10 am on Thursday, **June 2**, for students entering third year (also part-time students and combined-degree students), and on **June 9** for those entering second year.

1. Please check your registration status online for Fall and Winter 2011-12 before registration begins. You can do this through <http://dalonline.dal.ca>, or see the Registration Guide at <http://registrar.dal.ca/regguide/register/regstatus.html>. If your status is incorrect, please let me know ASAP, so I can have it corrected.

If you have outstanding fees, the online system will not let you register for classes.

2. **Please make sure you use the online version of the course selection materials (http://law.dal.ca/Current_Students/Course_Selection_Materials/) when determining your course choices. The hard copy version handed out in March is no longer up to date.**
3. There is a strong possibility Alternate Dispute Resolution will be rescheduled. We'll keep you posted.
4. Some courses, such as moots, placements, clerkships and DRPs, require permission from the law school before you can register. I'm currently placing overrides on the system to allow students to register in those special courses they've been approved for, and should be finished soon. I'll send each student notification, once the overrides have been placed.
