Subject: Canadian Labour Arbitration Moot

NOTICE TO INCOMING SECOND YEAR STUDENTS - Canadian Labour Arbitration Moot

Second year students who enroll in Labour Law during the fall term of 2011 may apply for a place on Dalhousie's team that will compete in the 2011 Canadian Labour Arbitration Moot Competition. The Schulich School of Law sends a team of two second year law students to this competition which is held annually in Toronto in late January. This moot will be of particular interest to students who wish to pursue a career in labour law. The moot provides an opportunity to develop research and advocacy skills and to meet labour practitioners, arbitrators, and law students from across Canada who are also interested in labour law.

Moot Team Selection:

The Labour Arbitration Moot team will be selected in early September. Selection is based on enrollment in Labour Law, an interview, and 1st year marks. If you wish to be considered for the team, please send me an email by **August 26, 2011** indicating your interest in the moot and providing your 1st year marks (an official transcript is not necessary).

Course Credit & Co-requisite:

Participation in this competitive moot is treated as a 2-credit hour course in the winter term, although preparation begins as soon as the moot problem is available, usually in early October. Only second year students are eligible for this moot. Enrollment in Labour Law is a co-requisite. (Please note that enrollment in Administration of the Collective Agreement is **not** a co-requisite for 2011-2012.)

Note: Students may not do more than one competitive moot for credit while at the Law School. Students selected for the labour arbitration moot team will not be eligible for other second year or for third year moots.
