Please note the following changes and updates to the 2011/12 timetable. Please make sure you use the ****ELECTRONIC VERSION**** of the course selection materials, timetable and exam schedules from now on, available at http://law.dal.ca/Current_Students/Course_Selection_Materials/ as the printed version handed out in March is not up to date.

- **International Humanitarian Law: Law of Armed Conflict (LAWS 2205.03)** has been moved from the fall term to the winter term because of the availability of the instructor. It is now scheduled in the winter term Thursdays 4:30-6:30 in room 304.
- **Canadian Legal History (LAWS 2123.03)** is not being offered.
- **Public Health Law (LAWS 2221.03)** is not being offered.
- **Administrative Law (LAWS 200.04)** (winter term section) is now being taught by Professor Lahey, not Professor Ginn. Please note Professor Lahey is also teaching the fall term section of Administrative Law, as originally scheduled. The times and days remain the same.
- **Current Issues in Labour and Employment Law: Innis Christie Visiting Professor (LAWS 2231.01)** - We now have the schedule for this is a one credit fall term intensive course taught by visiting professor Brian Langille. Please note that there are no prerequisites for this course but either Labour Law or Employment Law are co-requisites (i.e. to be eligible to take the Innis Christie intensive course, you must have either already taken one of these courses in the previous year OR be taking one of them concurrently in the fall term of 2011). Attendance at all classes is mandatory.

- **Dealing With The Past: Indian Residential Schools Settlement (LAWS 2227.01)** - We now have the schedule for this is a one credit fall term intensive course taught by Michael DeGagne and Professor Jennifer Llewellyn. There are no prerequisites or co-requisites for this course. Attendance at all classes is mandatory. The course will be evaluated by means of a short paper due after the end of the course.
