RENEWABLE AT \$13,000 IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS

The Law Foundation of Nova Scotia offers a variety of entrance scholarships for students entering Dalhousie Law School, including five \$13,000 scholarships, renewable at that level if conditions of continued eligibility are met at the end of first and second year. There is also the possibility of further scholarships of lesser amounts from year to year, when funds are available. Two additional scholarships of \$13,000 each will be awarded to the top-ranking student in both first and second years. These scholarships will exclude recipients of the Law Foundation of Nova Scotia Scholarships awarded to incoming first-year students. The Scholarships are tenable to any student regardless of nationality, domicile, gender or religion.

CONDITIONS OR QUALIFICATIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

- 1) have completed, with a superior academic average, at least three full years after junior matriculation or two full years after senior matriculation of a course leading to the degree of B.A., B.Sc., or B.Comm, or an equivalent degree at Dalhousie or at another degree-granting college or university recognized by the Senate of Dalhousie University.
- 2) be offered and accept a place in the First Year class at Dalhousie Law School. The Scholarship is contingent upon the recipient taking up attendance in the First Year class in September.
- 3) have a declared desire to study law, and
- 4) possess, in the opinion of the Faculty of law of Dalhousie University, those qualities that are needed for the attainment of distinction in the legal profession.

CONDITIONS FOR RENEWAL

- 1) Maintaining an A average or placing in the top 15 of his or her class.
- 2) If the scholarship is lost for second year, it will be renewed for third year if the required conditions are met.

METHOD OF SELECTION

Each candidate for a scholarship is required to make application using the form on reverse. It is to be postmarked not later than the last day of November and returned to:
