Dr. Aldo Chircop is a specialist in marine and environmental law and policy. A former director of the International Ocean Institute, he is a Professor of Law at Dalhousie Law School and an Associate of the Marine & Environmental Law Institute. He has published widely on ocean and coastal law, policy and management.

Dr. Moira L. McConnell is a Professor of Law and Director of the Marine & Environmental Law Institute (2004-2007) at Dalhousie Law School, Canada. Professor McConnell is also a special advisor to the IMO in connection with maritime labour issues and has consulted for the IMO. She is affiliated with graduate research programme in MBA in Shipping and Logistics (Copenhagen Business School). She has published in wide range of topics related to law of the sea, maritime and marine law and policy, and environmental law and policy.
