

Vincent Power Teaches New European Union Law Course

Dalhousie Law School was pleased to have a number of students participate in its condensed European Union Law course this past September. Students were fortunate to have Vincent Power, a lawyer specializing in European Union and Irish competition and transport law, teach the new one-credit course. Offered in connection with the European Union Centre of Excellence (EUCE), the course was taught for the first time in September 2007 and provided students with the opportunity to take a condensed course at the beginning of the term.

This year's professor is a Partner in the Corporate Department of A&L Goodbody Solicitors and advises clients around the world. He is the author or editor of six books including *Competition Law and Practice*, *Irish Competition Law* and the award-winning *EC Shipping Law*. Power has both a master's and a doctorate from Cambridge University and was the first ever law graduate to be awarded the Distinguished Alumnus award from University College Cork.
